

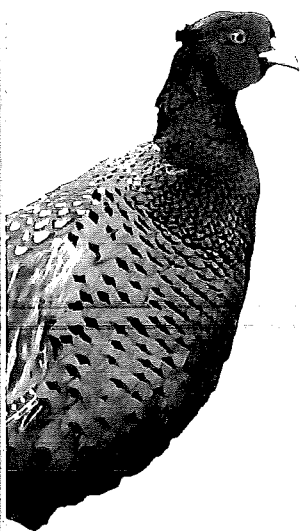


## Scotland facts

The most famous lake is called Loch Ness. It is very deep and very dark. In the summer you can go swimming here. And in the winter it is sometimes cold enough for people to skate on.

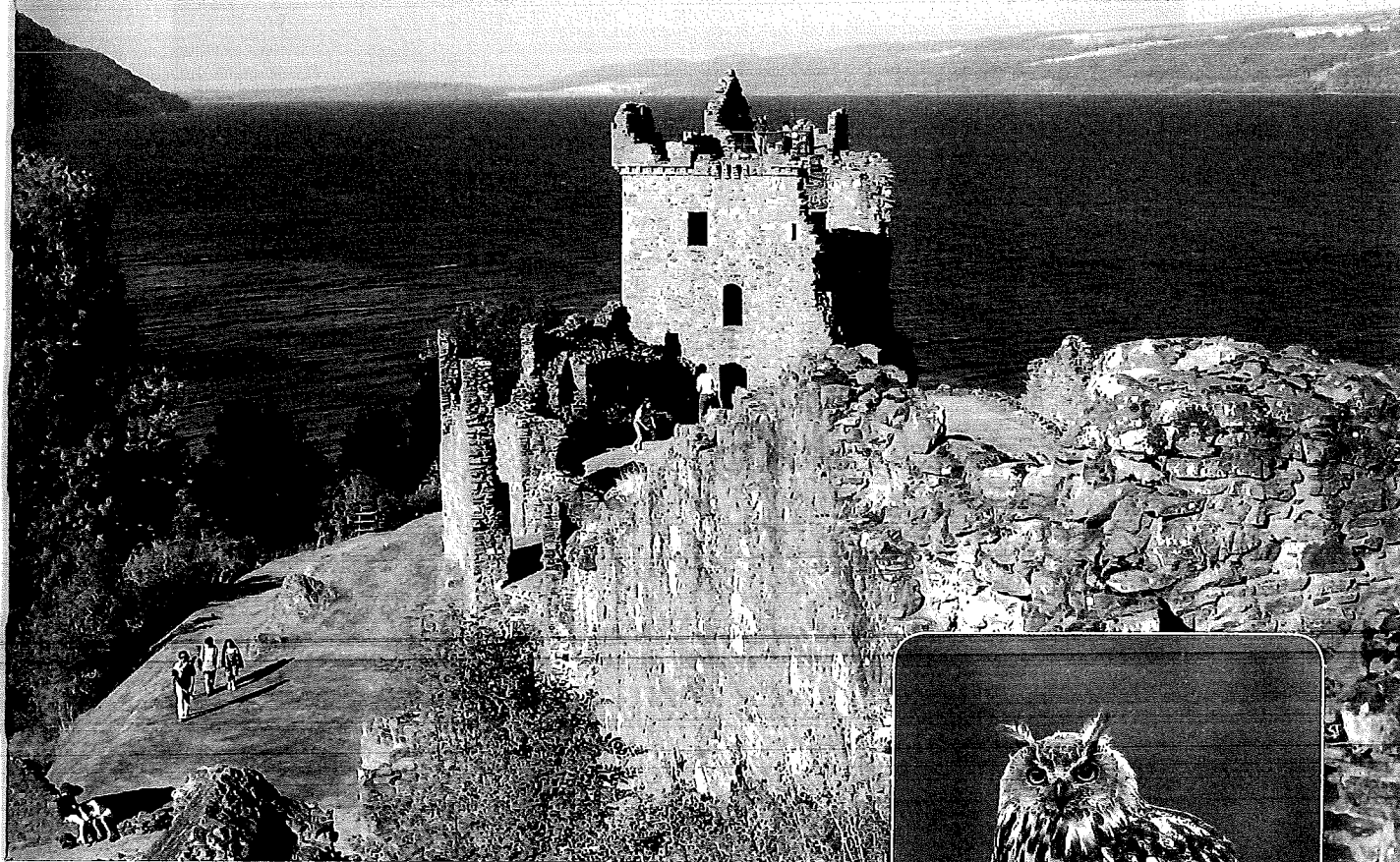

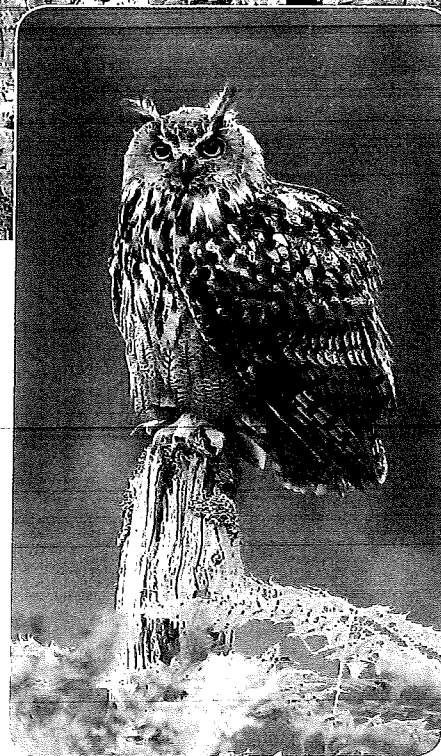
